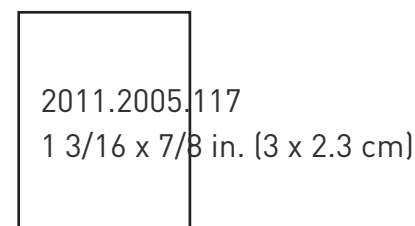


**10c Mahogany Logs in River, 1938**

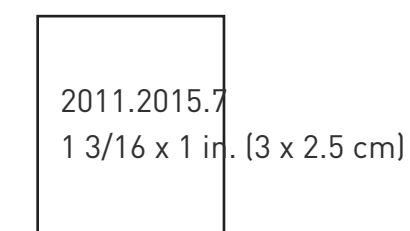


**4c Coat of Arms, 1863**

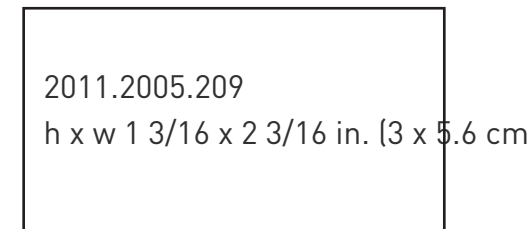

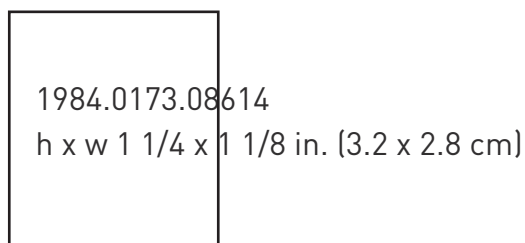

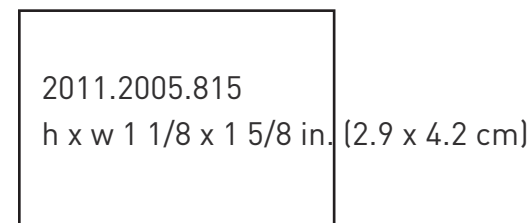

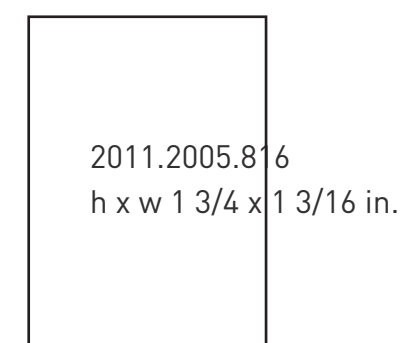
